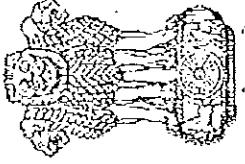

Sir,

Please find enclosed a copy of the above referred Drugs Controller General (India) notice, wherein it is stated that, if the importer has obtained NOC from Zonal office of CDSCO, Dual use items for non medicinal purposes need not to be referred to ADC and that these items may be cleared by Customs, after verification of label and by endorsing the quantity imported on the NOC

In view of the above, it is requested that this may please be brought to the notice of all your field officers and CFS for information and necessary compliance.

NOTICE

It has been decided that in case of drugs of dual use, for which NOC for import for non-medicinal purposes have been obtained from Zonal Offices of Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation under the provisions of Schedule D of the Drugs and Cosmetics Rules 1945, such items after being declared by the importer as not for medicinal use, need not to be referred to the port-offices by the Custom Authority for further NOC. However, the quantities of such items imported shall be verified by the Custom Authority at port and the same shall be endorsed on NOC issued by the Zonal Offices of Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation.

This is for ease of doing business.
